

## Alarming Moments of Life: Understanding & Helping

In ministering to people, we are constantly reminded that we live in a fallen world and experiencing the collateral damage it brings. Those among whom we minister often find themselves emotionally fragile and in need of our help. The first two sessions will provide a brief look at two elements that impact behavior and emotions, personality and culture. The final two sessions will be practical by sharing how to minister to emotional needs.

### Session 1 - Understanding People: A Biblical View of Personality

God created every human being in his image, each with a unique personality. This session examines various views on personality and its impact on the way we react and respond to our world.

### Session 2 - Understanding People: The Impact of Culture

A look at why people behave the way they do from a cultural perspective. No behavior happens in a vacuum, there are reasons we all engage our world in a certain way. The session looks at a model that addresses culture and understanding people.

### Session 3 - Listening: A Lost Art


The one thing lacking in most of our relationships is the importance of listening. This session focuses on how to regain the lost (or never discovered) art of listening. If you are willing to listen, there are always people who are willing to talk.

### Session 4 - Dealing with Problems: A Biblical Model

As we minister to people, we will always be confronted with problems both large and small. The session focuses on one model to address many of the issues faced from a Biblical perspective.

#### OUR SPEAKER NEIL GILLILAND, Ph.D.



In 2017, Neil resumed serving as director of member care at FWB International Missions where he served from 2001-2009. From Jan. 2010 – Dec. 2016, Neil's prior service included serving as member care consultant for FWBIM and as an adjunct professor at Welch College. Neil also serves as an adjunct online professor for Liberty University, does some counseling primarily with missionary families and premarital couples and keeps a fairly rigorous speaking schedule.

Neil grew up in the rural, southern Ohio community of Slocum Station and was saved at Porter FWB Church. After high school, Neil graduated in 1974 from Ohio State University with a psychology degree, then enrolled at Welch College to study Bible and missions. He met Sheila (Raper) and married her in 1977. Sheila and Neil served as house parents at the **Trula Cronk Home** for Children in E. Tennessee and for eight years as dorm parents at a boarding school for missionary children under International Missions in Côte d'Ivoire, West Africa, returning to the U.S. in 1987. Neil became director of recruitment for Welch. Nearly 20 years after graduating from OSU, Neil returned to graduate school completing an M.S. and Ph.D. in Counseling Psychology from Tennessee State University.

In his free time, Neil is an avid sports fan (especially Ohio State football), fishes every moment he can and listens to bluegrass music. His wife Sheila is a postpartum nurse. They have one married daughter, Hannah, who is 25 years old and a preschool-aged grandson.
